

Funding announcement for the transition assistance program

Washington | Medicaid

The transition assistance program (TAP) for Foundational Community Supports (FCS) members is out of funds for the first half of the 2024/2025 fiscal year as of August 29, 2024, at 5 p.m.

TAP has finite funds of \$2,700,000 available for the 2024/2025 fiscal year. Funding was split into two parts for the fiscal year. As of July 1, 2024, \$1,350,000 was available for TAP spending. The other \$1,350,000 will be available on January 1, 2025, for the remainder of the 2024/2025 fiscal year.

We will send an email notification to FCS members once the next round of TAP funding is available on January 1, 2025. Until then, new TAP requests will not be accepted.
